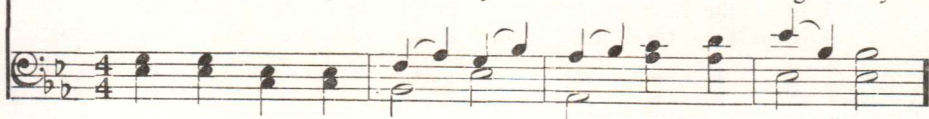

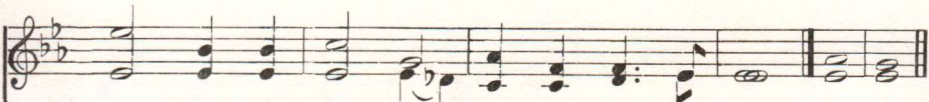
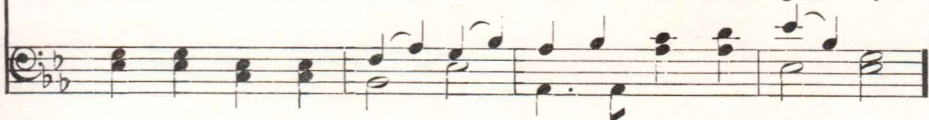
1. Ho - ly, ho - ly, ho - ly! Lord God Al - might - y!
