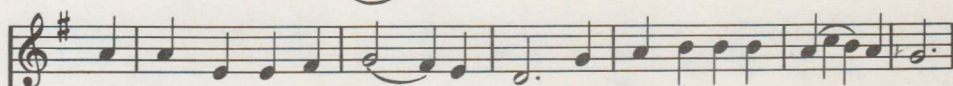
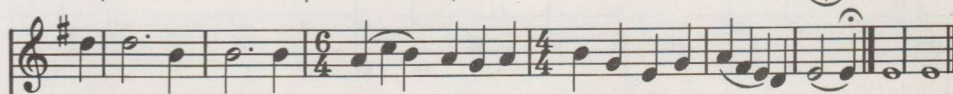


1. O come, O come, Em - man - u - el, And ran - som captive Is - ra - el,
